Philip St. Hill is currently the Deputy Consul General at the Consulate General of Barbados in Miami and has been since September 2006. Before taking up this position, he served as First Secretary at the Embassy of Barbados in Washington, DC (1998 – 2001) and Counselor at the Embassy of Barbados in Caracas, Venezuela (2001 – 2006). He joined the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in 1996 but has been a civil servant since 1977.

Mr. St. Hill holds a B.A. (Honors) in History and Social Studies from the University of the West Indies (UWI) and an M.A. in Theatre Arts and Literature from Florida State University (FSU), USA. He also holds an Advanced Diploma in Diplomacy and International Relations from the German Development Institute (1998) and a Certificate in Development Diplomacy from the DiploFoundation in Malta.

Mr. St. Hill is an award-winning poet and dramatist and is well-known in Barbados as a Master of Ceremony and comedian. He has published “Island Vibes”, a book of children’s poetry highlighting experiences of island life from the point of view of children.
